Fitting Instructions

Victorian/Victorian Winged/Georgian/Edwardian Door Surrounds

- 1. Measure from top of door opening to ground level. Measure pillar and trim off excess at bottom of pillar to the same size.
- 2. Hold pillar against wall and fix top and bottom with 1x3" screw/plug/white cap at top of flat section and 1x4" screw/plug/cap, bottom flat section take care not to over tighten screws as this will distort the pillar, and cause cracking.
- 3. Place top section above door and centralize over the two pillars. Top can then be fixed by using 2"screws/plugs/caps along top flange at approximately 300mm spacings.
- 4. Clean off all dust and dirt using a soft cloth ensuring not to scratch the gelcoat surface. We also recommend sweeping up all dust on site ready for the next step.
- 5. Finish off by sealing around your new surround using silicone sealant of the appropriate colour.
- 6. Your surround will look good for many years. All that is necessary is to clean with warm soapy water and a soft cloth at regular intervals.

6 x 2" screws

10 x rawlplugs

10 x screw cover caps

2 x tubes silicon
