## **Victorian Portico Fitting Instructions**

- 1. Place columns in correct position and draw around bottom edges.
- 2. Make 2x2 timber frame to fit inside of the column, position timber frame and screw down to the floor, sit the column over the timber frame.
- 3. Repeat the process at the top of the column, using a rounded piece of plywood or blockboard, screw this in position on the underside of the portico ceiling.
- 4. Place the portico on top of the columns so the blockboard drops inside the hole in the top of the column.
- 5. The portico top will need to be temporary supported against the wall with a batten or a prop until it has been securely fixed with plugs and screws, the temporary supports can then be removed.
- 6. Clean off any dust or dirt using soft cloth prior to sealing with silicon sealant where necessary.

<sup>\*</sup>Electric cable can be fitted prior to portico top being fixed to the wall if light is to be installed on the ceiling.
